Please continue to tell us what you like about nursery and what you feel we can do better. If you wish to be anonymous then just put it in the suggestion box in the entrance.

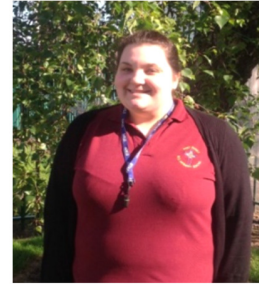
HOME BAGS
