Safety Issue – Parking

One of the areas identified by Ofsted to be of concern was the dangerous parking of cars at the beginning and end of the school day. The zig zag lines are painted on the road adjacent to the school gates to help keep our children safe. Please keep off the zig zag lines. Also please do not park on the footpaths especially on the corners of the road opposite the school. This again causes a danger to the children and to other drivers. We are working with the local authority to find ways of addressing the dangerous parking situation. Please help us by thinking about where you park. Thank you.

Please note: SATS dates for Year 6

SATS will be taken in the week of 8th May this year. The timetable for exams is given by the Department for Education and can only be deviated from in exceptional circumstances. If your child misses a test because they are on an unauthorized holiday in term time, he/she will not be able to take the test on another day and will be officially recorded as having “not met the required standard”.

This impacts on the child and the school too as overall results will show the absent child as having “failed”
